

HIGH DURABILITY SITE DUMPERS FROM TEREX – RENTAL TOUGH

A common sight on job sites throughout the UK, Terex dumpers are now being distributed in Australia. The latest models include the TA5, TA6, TA7, TA5S and TA6S.

Semco says these British workhorses are seen on most UK job sites and many Australian contractors are now realising their potential as an invaluable tool for shifting small amounts of material in any weather on jobs where access is tight or the terrain is difficult.

“Often the only loading equipment available is an excavator which usually has limited mobility with a maximum speed of six kilometres an hour. In contrast, the all wheel drive Terex site dumper can go almost anywhere at speeds up to nearly 30 kilometres per hour” says Semco’s Dave Freeburn.

“Featuring reliable Kubota or Perkins diesel engines and simple controls, wet disc brakes and rapid dumping, these units are also ideally suited to the rental markets where they bring an excellent return on investment.

Terex dumpers are low maintenance and come ready for work, fully lockable with an open foldable ROPS frame. The initial range includes the compact HD1200 Hydrostatic model with 1200 kg payload through to the TA6 Power shuttle shift with a 6,000 kg payload.

These rugged machines are built with a thick steel skip base plate with reinforced box sections for high strength and longevity and exceptional service access and ease of maintenance built into every machine. High ground clearance and a low centre of gravity give the dumpers superb stability and site accessibility.

Power Tip and Power Swivel functions allow for either forward tipping or effective placement of the load to either side – very useful for trench filling or small sites”, Freeburn said.
