

DUMPERS ADD FLEXIBILITY TO WATER CART BUSINESS

In response to requests from construction sites, a Sydney water truck hire company has added dumper hire to its range of services.

The Watercart Specialists dry hires a range of water trucks and has identified an opportunity to expand its business by adding dumpers to its fleet.

Other uses include filling water barricades or providing water for catering and cleaning, large pool fills, concrete sawing and pressure cleaning.
